Have you ever had an eye operation or an eye injury? <sup>2</sup>			
Do you have a history of high or low blood pressure? <sup>2</sup>			
Have you ever been on a prolonged course of cortisone (steroid) medication? <sup>2</sup>			

If you have answered 'yes' or 'unsure' to one or more of these questions you may be at a higher risk of developing glaucoma.
